Traffic Safety Assessment by IDOT to be discussed

The Illinois Department of Transportation recently conducted a Traffic Safety Assessment for the Walnut and Lawrence intersection and the MacArthur and Lawrence intersection. These two intersections have been problematic for years. Around 2003, the city placed High Accident Intersection signs at the approach of each intersection. Due to the residential nature of the neighborhood, widening the road and building turn lanes is not practical. Join us in a discussion with City Traffic Engineer Lori Williams to share your opinions and ideas about this issue. What is the HWSNA?

The Historic West Side Neighborhood Association was established in the 70's to fight zoning changes that altered the residential character of the neighborhood. In 1983, the HWSNA convinced the city council to "down zone" the entire area to an 'R-3,' single-family zoning classification to stem the increasing conversion of homes into commercial use and multi-family rental housing.
