The Historic West Side Neighborhood Association (HWSNA) was established in the late 1970s, primarily to fight a zoning change that would have altered the residential character of the neighborhood.

In 1983, the HWSNA convinced the city council to 'down zone' the entire area to an 'R-3' single-family zoning classification to stem the increasing conversion of homes into commercial uses and multifamily rental housing. Since that time, the HWSNA has been a steady voice of continuity before the City Planning Commission and City Council to maintain the residential character of the area.

In 2001, the name was officially changed from the West Side Neighborhood Association to the Historic West Side Neighborhood Association. The HWSNA is a non-profit organization.
